We have always counted on your generosity and we are doing so again. Thank you very much for helping us and know that you have contributed to the well-being of your retired priests from Alexandria-Cornwall.

UPDATE ON AMALGAMATION OF DIOCESES OF OTTAWA AND ALEXANDRIA-CORNWALL

- The Bishops of Ontario have given their unanimous approval to the amalgamation.
- Archbishop Mulhall of Kingston, our metropolitan, has also given his consent.
- As of 1st September 2019, Alexandria-Cornwall is no longer part of the Toronto Regional Marriage Tribunal. All marriage tribunal cases for Alexandria-Cornwall will be dealt with by the marriage tribunal for the Archdiocese of Ottawa. (Information of how to proceed will be forwarded to the clergy within the next few weeks).
- The two diocese have printed a dual directory for 2019-2020. The directory will be circulated shortly.
- Our lawyers have begun working on the civil unification of our two episcopal corporations.
