EMBS PRIESTS' PENSION PLAN

We held our second annual priests' pension collection last November. You may recall that we had collected \$118,226 the first year which was overwhelming. Last year generated another generous amount of \$77,731. We want you to know how much we appreciate your concern for our welfare. We were able to increase the amount of monthly pension from \$750 to \$800 effective 1st July of this year. We hope to ultimately reach \$1,100 per month but must increase the amount gradually in view of the cost. Our annual collection this year will take place 2nd November.
