AMALGAMATION OF ALEXANDRIA-CORNWALL AND OTTAWA

The petition proposes that the two entities become one archdiocese and that the name of the new archdiocese be the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall. DEVELOPMENT & PEACE

In October 2017, Pope Francis announced a Special Assembly of the Synod of Bishops for the Pan-Amazon Region. What is a synod? The word comes from the Greek roots, 'syn', meaning 'together', and 'hodos', meaning 'path', suggesting journeying together. A synod is thus about walking in community in one direction to respond to issues important to the Church. The special synod, to be held from 6-27 October 2019 is distinct in having been convened on a question that pertains to a specific region of the world. Its theme will be Amazonia: New Paths for the Church and for an Integral Ecology. This is an opportunity to better understand the Amazon biome, rich in life and biodiversity and vital to the balance of the Earth, our common home. It is also a time to 'walk' with indigenous and local communities in the Amazon, to listen to what they say about their needs and to support them in their quest for a dignified life.
