# REV. DEACON GORDON BRYAN - 40TH ANNIVERSARY OF ORDINATION

It was 40 years ago on 10th September 1976 that Gordie was ordained a deacon here at St. Francis de Sales by Bishop Eugene LaRocque. He was the very first permanent deacon ordained for our diocese.

Since that time, Gordie has faithfully served in a number of our parishes, including his first assignment at St. Jean Bosco. Over the next four decades, he would also spend time assisting at St. Francis de Sales, St. Columban's, Blessed Sacrament, St. Peter's and Precious Blood in Glen Walter.

In addition to his duties as a permanent deacon, Gordie was named the coordinator of the diocesan deacon formation program in 1978 and in 1994 became responsible for the diocese's permanent deacons.



Deacons are particularly called to bring Christ's service outside of church buildings and ecclesial structures into their workplaces and family lives. Gordie did this in spades by his committed involvement to church and community organizations too numerous to name, but included: the Knights of Columbus, the Children's Aid Society, the Children's Treatment Centre, St. Joseph's Villa, Meals on Wheels and the St. Vincent de Paul Society. In 1975 Gordie was recognized as Cornwall's Citizen of the Year.

He also served for many years as a director of Notre-Dame Cemetery and the Hotel Dieu Hospital. In 1984, Gordie and his family relocated to Zambia for one year to teach at the Bahati Minor Seminary and to help look after the spiritual care of the boys.

Unlike a priest, a permanent deacon may have a wife, a family, and a secular job. Gordie has been happily married to Françoise Martin for 60 years! (25 August 1956). They are proud parents of five children: Gordon, Paul, Maureen, Nancy and Joanne. They are also grandparents to nine grandchildren and three great-granddaughters.

After spending a number of years working in, and then buying, his family's magazine wholesale business, Gordie became somewhat disenchanted with the type of magazines being published. In 1973, he sold the business and accepted the position of director of the diocesan centre for the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall. In 1982, Bishop LaRocque named him diocesan bursar. In his role as bursar, he was responsible for overseeing the diocese's financial affairs, a job that he excelled at. He retired in 2006. Congratulations Gordie and our thanks to you for 40 years of dedicated service.


