MASS INTENTIONS

Part 5 - What happens when we offer a Mass intention in a parish?

When Mass intentions are received, the parish makes a commitment to try to insure that these intentions will be honoured in a timely fashion. Many parishioners would like to see these Masses celebrated on a weekend, but unfortunately with only 52 weekends in a year and with one Mass already designated for the intentions of all the parishioners, it sometimes limits the availability of weekend Masses. Most parishes have weekday Masses on a regular basis and therefore some of these Mass intentions will be honoured at that time. It may not always be possible for families to be present but the important thing is that the Mass intention is celebrated. In the event that a parish should receive more Masses than can be celebrated in a particular year, the intentions will then be forwarded to the diocese to be shared with other parishes, Catholic institutions, retired priests or the Bishop, who do not have a regular community that provides Mass intentions to them.
