MASS INTENTIONS

Part 6 - Why should I make a Mass offering for someone?

In the last number of years, we have seen an increased number of donations being made at the time of death to worthwhile charities. This is an admirable gesture. The monies received are often used for research, prevention and support of other charities, and this practice should be encouraged. As Catholic Christians, however, the practice of remembering our loved ones in prayer should also be remembered. This is not in competition with other charities, but a means of encouraging the remembrance of the deceased on their Christian journey. Mass offerings may be made at the time of death of a friend or loved one. They may also be made to celebrate an anniversary of a death. During the month of November in particular, it is a tradition within the Church to remember our dead and what greater tribute can we give them than to have a Mass offered on their behalf.

Let us not forget that Masses may also be offered for the intentions of the living, be it for birthdays, anniversaries, illness, other occasions and in thanksgiving.
