Part 4 - Why is there a cost for a Mass offering? (a stipend)

If the sacraments are free we may ask "Why do we have to pay to have a Mass celebrated?" The answer of course is we do not pay to have the Mass celebrated, because the Mass by its very nature is priceless. We make an offering at the time when we receive the Mass card and this offering is meant to be a gift to the Church in order to continue the mission of Christ. In our Diocese, the present suggested offering is \$15.00. This money is divided in the following way: \$3 goes to the parish for its maintenance and upkeep, \$8 to the celebrant, and \$4 is designated for the priests pension fund.


