While there have been and continue to be changes to the church building, it remains a holy place for parishioners and visitors to assemble and worship as a Parish community of faith, hope and charity.

These require a separate entrance for priest and penitent and a dividing wall between them. The Reconciliation Room has only one entrance and no complete barrier between priest and penitent. I am sorry for any inconvenience this may cause. Anyone wanting to make a confession but not wishing or able to use the current Confessional, may contact me at the office to make an appointment or simply tap me on the shoulder before/after any Mass.
