

# Archbishop's Annual Charity Dinner Wednesday, October 22th 2014, 6:00 Reception / 7:00 Dinner

The Annual Archbishop's Charity Dinner is again scheduled for this coming October at the Ottawa Conference and Event Centre. We invite you to mark your calendars and to share the date with your committees and parishioners.

This is the primary charity event of our diocesan Church. By designating the *Multifaith Housing initiative* and the *Bruyère Village* as beneficiaries of this year's Charity Dinner, Archbishop Prendergast hopes that we will become even more aware of the urgent need to provide decent affordable housing for those with lower incomes and for our elders in the Ottawa region.

We would appreciate any help that you can give us in promoting this event with your parishioners and with your parish organizations such as the Knights of Columbus and the Catholic Women's League.

Tickets will once again be \$130 each (\$60 income tax receipt for individual purchases) and \$1,170 for a table of nine. An online ticket order form is now available on our web site www.CatholicOttawa.ca under Archbishop / Archbishop's Charity Dinner.

Our Parish plans to take a table again this year and Fr. Bill has invited the Knights of Columbus, CWL and Pro-Life Ministries to purchase tickets for their members to join the parish table of nine. Please note that Canada Revenue Agency's regulations state that we <u>cannot issue tax receipts</u> for donations made to Mission Co-Op Collections.


## **Sunday Morning Smile:**
