end of the Christmas season. Today's feast of the Presentation of the Lord seems to extend the Incarnation celebration a bit longer. In fact, some have called this feast a "second Epiphany."

The first reading recalls the anticipation of Advent, as Malachi writes, "Lo, I am sending my messenger to prepare the way before me." The reading from Hebrews reminds us of the Incarnation, proclaiming that Jesus had a "share" in our own "blood and flesh." The Gospel finds the infant Jesus on his first visit to Jerusalem and his human parents once again surprised and in awe over the events surround his birth.

In the simplicity of the manger, in the grandeur of the temple, in the domesticity of Nazareth, Jesus comes. May we come to know him and so be filled with "wisdom" and the "favor of God."

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Who should go?

- Non-Catholics, both baptized and non-baptized who wish to learn more about the Catholic faith.
- Catholics who have not been taught the basics or wish a refresher or have not completed the Sacraments of Initiation.
- Sponsors/spouses/fiancé(e)s of non-catholic participants.

What is it? A process of self-study, discussion and opportunities for questions held in the context of prayer and listening to God. A team of parishioners "journey" with you. There is **no obligation** on the part of any non-Catholic to become a Catholic. This is always your own **free choice**.

When? The process is not a quick fix and requires commitment to the program over a period of 8 months or so. Our parish plans on starting a new course in September so that participants can be prepared to be brought into full communion with the Catholic church at the Easter Vigil.
