The Canonical Norms for Lent are as

follows: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

Fasting binds all persons who have completed their 18th birthday through those who have completed their 59th year, unless prevented by poor health. On days of fast, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's own needs. Eating between meals is not allowed although fluids may be taken.

Abstinence binds all persons who have completed their 14th birthday, unless prevented by poor health. In the Archdiocese of Ottawa, the consumption of meat is not allowed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. Religious practices such as daily Mass, going to Confession, the Stations of the Cross, works of charity and justice, and acts of self-denial are highly encouraged.



Stations of the Cross in Lent - This prayer commemorates Our Lord's passion and death on the cross and will be held in the church on all Friday evenings during Lent, beginning this Friday, February 28th at 7:00pm. All are welcome to attend. It is a great Lenten prayer to help appreciate the sacrifice that Jesus made for us. Various ministries lead each evening's prayer. Schedule: Schedule:


