How Do I Book an Unannounced Mass Intention?

Unannounced Masses can be booked at the Parish Office for various reasons: for the deceased '†', 'for the health' of an individual or 'for the intentions' of an individual – possibly for a birthday, anniversary or because they are going through a tough time.

Unannounced Masses cost **\$10**, all of which goes directly to the celebrant (An Announced Mass costs \$15). A Mass Card can be supplied to inform the individual or their family that a Mass has been requested. The main differences from an Announced Mass are :

- The date of the Mass is not specified and
- The intention will not be published in the bulletin.
