<u>Relic of St. Francis Xavier:</u> Public viewing here at St. John the Apostle, <u>February 1st, 10:00am</u> to 5:00pm.

His body is in Goa, India, but the right forearm with which he baptized untold tens of thousands of people is preserved in the Jesuit mother church in Rome. FIRST COMMUNION - RITE OF ENROLLMENT

This weekend **January 6/7**, we will celebrate the Rite of Enrolment with the children and their families who are preparing for the sacraments of **Reconciliation and First Communion**.

All children who are registered to receive First Communion during the Easter season of 2018 are required to attend one of the three Masses this weekend.

CONFIRMATION - RITE OF ENROLLMENT

Next weekend <u>January 13/14</u>, we will celebrate the Rite of Enrolment with the children and their families who are preparing for the sacrament of **Confirmation**.

All children who are registered to be Confirmed in April, 2018 are required to attend one of the three Masses that weekend.

This is the first formal stage in the preparation of children for the sacraments of initiation. Parents bring their children to the Church and present them to the community. The faith community to which the child belongs has the duty and privilege of witnessing and supporting them in their journey towards full initiation in the Church. The children will express their desire to begin preparations for the sacraments and the parents accept the responsibility of supporting their children during the preparations. As well as accepting these candidates, the parish community promises to offer them support through their prayers and example. The Rite of Enrolment is not something nice we do for the candidates. The parish community is called not to be an observer of the rite but an active participant in it.
