LAUDATE SI' ("Praise be to you, my Lord"): Pope Francis has released his encyclical on the environment, entitled *Laudate Si'* (http://w2.vatican.va/content/francesco/en/encyclicals/documents/papa-francesco_20150524_enciclica-laudato-si.html). Through a clearly defined moral framework our Holy Father calls us to care for the Earth and all of its peoples, including future generations. The Most Reverend Terrence Prendergast, SJ, Archbishop of Ottawa, made the following statement in response to this encyclical on the environment: "We have been waiting with great anticipation for Pope Francis' encyclical concerning care for God's creation. Saint John Paul II and Pope Emeritus Benedict set the stage for this encyclical through their writings that recognized the urgent need for each of us to take responsibility in the care of all creation through building a culture of life and our duty to bequeath a healthy planet to future generations. Pope Francis provides us with a clearly defined moral framework to address the impact of climate change and environmental degradation on humanity, especially the poor and on all life on earth. As Archbishop of Ottawa, I encourage everyone to absorb his words, helping ensure that Gospel values serve as the basis of our daily lives."
