Statue of St. John the Apostle

We recently received approval from the archdiocesan College of Consultors to pursue the purchase of a statue of our patron. The wooden statue will be hand-carved and painted, five feet tall, and made in Italy. The total cost will be in the area of \$18,000. **We are now looking for donors for this project.** Donations can be made through the office (613-829-1760) or placed in the collection basket. Envelopes for this purpose will be available the first week of July. Tax receipts will be issued for all donations. Any donor who gives \$1,000 or more may have his or her name, or the name of someone in whose memory the donation is made, placed on a brass plate with the statue.
