Syro-Malabar Community at St. John

the Apostle: Over a week ago I was privileged to have Bishop Jose Kalluvilil, Apostolic Exarch of the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church in Canada, staying in my rectory. He was here for the consecration of Bishop Scott McCaig. The Syro-Malabar Church is one of the 22 Eastern Catholic Churches (sometimes called "Rites") in full communion with the Pope. The Church claims apostolic foundations through St. Thomas and most of its members live in India. Until now the small Syro-Malabar community in Ottawa has had no permanent pastor so its members attended local Roman Catholic parishes, including our own. When a Syro-Malabar priest or deacon was available the community has on occasion used our church for devotions and liturgies. This month a Syro-Malabar priest will be arriving in Ottawa to minister to the community. They have no church of their own so the Archdiocese has agreed to allow them to use our church building for their worship and gatherings. Where their pastor will reside still needs to be decided. While details need to be worked out the Syro-Malabar community will likely worship here on Sunday afternoons, possibly around 5:00pm. This does not conflict with our own Sunday morning worship. Most of their social gatherings will likely accompany their Sunday worship. I have been assured that this arrangement will not cause any financial burden to our parish. Their community is small but will seek to cover any additional costs arising from use of our church and Hall. Like us they are members of the Catholic Church and in a spirit of fraternal love I hope the parishioners of St John the Apostle will welcome them into our midst.
