## Social Outreach – Volunteers Needed

On March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2016, 13 refugee families presented themselves completely unexpectedly at the Morrison Gardens Food Outlet requesting food. This is more than the usual number of clients we serve from 10 – 12 on a Wednesday morning. Of course, the usual number also turned up. Together, they completely cleaned us out. We had to go for more food at mid morning, again in the afternoon and again on Thursday, March 10<sup>th</sup>.to replenish our shelves for Friday. Shortage of food or cash to provide is <u>not yet a problem</u>. What is needed is more volunteers, especially ones with vehicles to help us integrate the refugees into our system in a way that will not compromise our level of services for anyone.
