Ontario Chief Medical Officer of Health announces changes to COVID Safety Guidelines affecting Religious services, taking effect Monday, March 21st

- --- Indoor masking no longer required in select public settings, including our churches. We ask that everyone be respectful of each other's decision to continue to wear a mask or not.
- --- Parishioners are still encouraged to continue self-screening for Covid-19 symptoms and stay at home if you have any symptoms or are not feeling well.
- --- The use of hand sanitizer upon entry remains a good practice and is encouraged.
- --- The Greeting of Peace can resume in any manner that you are comfortable with, a wave, a nod, etc.
- --- Holy Communion on the tongue can resume.
- --- Confessions will resume in the confessional at the back of the Church.
- --- All restrictions are removed from meetings and gatherings, including parish halls and office.

The Archbishop is extending the dispensation from attending Mass in person on Sundays until the vigil Mass for Palm Sunday, April 9th. Beginning on Palm Sunday, parishioners are invited once again to attend Mass in person unless for reasons of health they cannot do so at this time. Catholics are reminded that the obligation to attend Sunday Mass does not apply if for health reasons you cannot attend Mass in person.
