# FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Jesus proclaimed that he came into the world to make the sightless see and the seeing blind. A difficult saving! But surely it must mean

that Jesus intended to take our ordinary ways of looking at things and turn them inside out. Jesus came to change our perspective. When the prophet Samuel went out to select the new king, he chose a young man who had the look of royalty about him. But God told him not to judge by appearances. God told Samuel – and today tells us – to change our perspective and to look at things and people differently. We are like the Ephesians, whom Paul urged to live as children of the light. With the light of faith, we have a new way of looking at things, and we are called to bring that new vision to the world around us. This is a great vocation, a calling to wake people up to what's really important.

# **EVA OLSSON: HOLOCAUST SURVIVOR**

Dr. Olsson was 19 years old when in 1944, her Jewish family was taken from their home in Hungary to Auschwitz-Birkenau camp. She managed to survive and travels Canada telling her story and speaking out against hatred and intolerance. She will be speaking at our church on Monday, April 10 at 7:00pm in the Main Hall. 
