Message from our Archbishop with regard to the Coronavirus and precautions

<u>recommended:</u> Wash one's hands, cough into one's sleeve and avoid touching one's face. If you are unwell, you should stay home: the Sunday obligation does not bind those who are ill.

Other steps that should be taken include: having disinfectants available at all entrances; to suspend the greeting of peace and the reception of Holy Communion from the chalice. Let's follow these precautions throughout Lent, unless and until other decisions are taken.


