Social Outreach Committee News

Sharing Our Christmas

The St. John the Apostle Social Outreach Committee would like to thank our parishioners for their kind donations to the 2018 Sharing Our Christmas Initiative. We worked in cooperation with the Sharing and Caring Network to ensure that there were no duplication of services, and we are happy to say that all applicants to St. John the Apostle's Sharing our Christmas initiative were able to receive gift cards for the purchase of much needed groceries at either Metro or Food Basics. Thanks to the generous donations of parishioners received during Advent, 123 households comprised of 826 children, adults and seniors living within our catchment area had a merrier Christmas.

Foodbank

The St. John the Apostle Social Outreach Committee also works with the Morrison Gardens Emergency Food Outlet (MGEFO) and Ottawa Foodbank throughout the year, and has done so for many years under the volunteer leadership of Lawrence Donegan. We serve a large area within St. John the Apostle parish. During 2018 our "Foodbank" served 365 households comprised of 1,183 individuals (495 children, 665 adults and 23 seniors). MGEFO is run entirely by volunteers, many from this parish, and we are always happy for new volunteers to join us. MGEFO is open for clients Monday evenings, Wednesday and Friday mornings. Volunteers are also needed on Monday mornings.


