(Excerpt from an article by Melissa Musick Nussbaum for *Celebration* entitled 'More Marriage Prep This June, Weddings shouldn't drive couples into debt':

....The study looked at 3,000 adults in the country who were, or had been, married. Turns out, the ones who spent a lot of money on the ring and/or the wedding were the ones most likely to be dividing up the wedding gifts in a marital split. The economists ran the numbers: Men who spent \$2,000 to \$4,000 on an engagement ring were 1.3 times more likely to wind up in divorce court than men who spent \$500 to \$2,000. Women whose weddings cost \$20,000 or more were 3.5 times more likely to end up in divorce court than women who spend \$5,000 to \$10,000. The women least likely to divorce? Those who spent less than \$1,000 on the wedding......
