50th Anniversary – Pastor's Message

I am privileged to be your pastor on this historic occasion of the 50th anniversary of the founding of Saint John the Apostle Parish. I share in your pride and joy. I want to thank the members of the 50th Anniversary Committee and volunteers who have put so much time and effort into the various events and celebrations of this year, especially, but not exclusively, the gala dinner, photo directory, and this 50th anniversary Mass and its reception. Without them this occasion would not have received the attention it so richly deserves. I would like to briefly recount the beginnings of our parish fifty years ago.

In the 1960s the population of Ottawa was expanding into Nepean and creating the need for another parish to be established in the region to properly serve the Catholic faithful. And so on October 8, 1966 Archbishop Lemieux established the parish of Saint John the Apostle and appointed Father John Whelan as its founding pastor. On October 16th the parish celebrated its first Sunday Mass in the gym of St. Raymond's School. It would continue to be the gathering place of weekend worship for the next three years. In September 1968 ground breaking took place for the construction of our church. Construction began in February 1969 and the first Mass was celebrated in the new building on August 10 of that same year. The church was blessed and the altar consecrated on December 27, 1969, the Feast Day of Saint John the Apostle, by Archbishop Plourde.

Over the decades many Catholic families and individuals have called St. John the Apostle Church their spiritual home. They have worshipped God together and received the sacraments under nine pastors and administrators. We have celebrated baptisms and weddings together, mourned and commended our departed to God, and have received Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.

*May the good Lord continue to watch over and bless our parish. May Our Lady and Saint John intercede on our behalf. God bless all of you and congratulations! **Fr. Lindsay***
