Spruce Tree: Our church property is surrounded by some pleasant vegetation, including the blue spruce adjacent the eastern entrance of the Glass House. Unfortunately back in 2014, the tree showed signs of disease and became a source of carpenter ants. At that time the Building & Grounds Sub-Committee decided it would be best to fell the tree but could not receive permission from the City of Ottawa. Instead only its top was removed. Since then further decay has occurred and the tree is still infested with carpenter ants. The plan of the Building & Grounds Sub-Committee once again is to remove the tree.

Parking Area Repairs: These repairs, completed by Amiko, included crack-filling, patching and the improvement of the base for the asphalt in one area. The cost was \$7,833 + HST. *Building & Grounds Sub-Committee*
