"Blue Envelopes" - Parish Social Mission

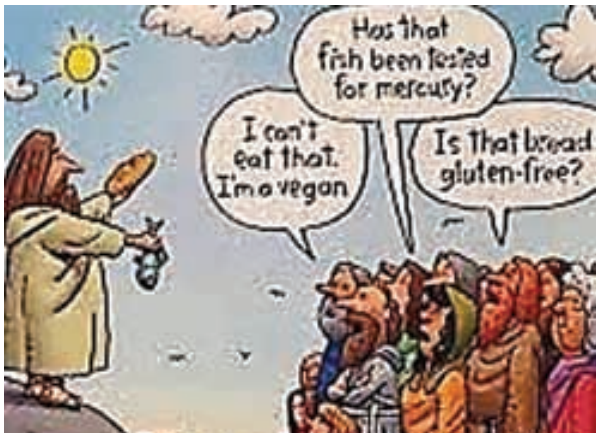
