Closing the Door of Mercy

The Jubilee Year of Mercy ends on Nov. 20. The Door of Mercy at Notre Dame Cathedral will close a week earlier on **Sun. Nov. 13 at 7.30 pm.** To receive the plenary indulgence one must be completely detached from all sins when passing through the Door of Mercy, recite the Apostle's or Nicene Creed at the cathedral and pray for the Holy Father's intentions, and within about 20 days before or after the pilgrimage receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Holy Communion. Those too sick or elderly to make the pilgrimage can still receive the Jubilee indulgence by reciting the Creed and praying for the Pope's intentions, and only if possible, receiving Holy Communion and Reconciliation.
