THE VICTORIOUS SERVANT OF GOD REIGNS [Third Sunday of Eastertide]

Jesus Christ is the Victorious Servant of God who opens our eyes and hearts to experience His presence. When Helen Keller was not quite two years old she had a high fever which caused her to become deaf and blind. Unable to see nor hear, she felt lost. She would hang on to her mother's skirt to get around. She could recognize people only by feeling their faces or their clothes. In today's Gospel Cleopas and his friend, walking on the road to Emmaus encountered Jesus. Even though their vision and hearing was not physically impaired, they did not recognize Jesus until the breaking of the bread. This scriptural passage reminds us to look for Jesus present in our lives. The words from another Gospel, Matthew 25, haunt us: "Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or away from home or naked or ill or in prison and not attend to your needs?" Serving each other, especially "those on the margins" in God's Reign, will help us to meet the Risen Saviour on our life's journey.

There are many environmentally friendly cleaning and laundry products available at local grocery stores that do not contain chemicals that are harmful to the environment. Vinegar and water is an effective window and glass cleaner. It also is an effective floor and surface cleaner! As well it can be used in place of fabric softener for delicate skin! Lemon juice is a natural bleach agent for clothing that is stained! Baking soda and vinegar used together are amazing scale removers for kettles and pots.
