

On the Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Elijah finds God, not in the thunder and driving wind, but in a gentle breeze. We repeat the gospel we heard a few days ago as Peter's fear gets the best of him when Jesus calls him out of his boat in a stormy sea. Peter takes his eyes off of Jesus and would have perished without Jesus' rescuing him.

God's love belongs to all of us, according to the readings of the Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In Isaiah, God promises "my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples." Paul, in his Letter to the Romans, tells us "the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable" and refers to himself as the "Apostle to the Gentiles." In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus hears the pleas of a "foreign" woman, a Canaanite who begs Jesus to heal her daughter.

consumption, waste and environmental change has so stretched the planet's capacity that our contemporary lifestyle, unsustainable as it is, can only precipitate catastrophes, such as those which even now periodically occur in different areas of the world. The effects of the present imbalance can only be reduced by our decisive action, here and now. We need to reflect on our accountability before those who will have to endure the dire consequences." Did you know that Earth <u>Overshoot Day</u> 2017 occurred on August 2nd. What this means is that from January until now we will have used more resources from nature than our planet can renew/replace in the whole year! We have used more ecological services than nature can regenerate; through overfishing, overharvesting of forestry products, and more over emissions of carbon dioxide into the atmosphere than forests can sequester! We must try to stop **Overshoot Day** from creeping further ahead in our calendar year each year! Each of us must make a commitment to reduce the expansion of our Global Footprint beyond what the planet can renew! **How** can we do this?

- Live Simply! Buy Less of Everything: ask yourself do I need it or do I want it!
- Repair and Reuse items that can be reused!
