

ST. RAPHAEL GREEN CORNER

Pope Francis writes: "... There is also a need to protect those common

areas, visual landmarks and urban landscapes which increase our sense of belonging, of rootedness, of "feeling at home" ... Laudato Si #151 During the summer we all love to spend time out doors travelling and stopping for picnics, hosting guests for backyard barbecues, and slowing down our pace of life and making life a bit simpler for everyone. It is important to remember that as we engage in all of these activities that we must try to remain as conscious and sensitive to the needs of Our Planet as well! Avoid waste-Consider using reusable dishes and cutlery, rather than disposables at your barbecues and outings, at home or/and at the cottage!

- -Say no to plastic plates and plastic cutlery. If you're having a small gathering, use your own plates (reusable ones) and your own cutlery.
- -If the event is so big that using your own plates is not an option, make sure you opt for <u>biodegradable utensils and plates</u> for the guests such as paper plates.
- -Another important consideration: Try to avoid buying pre-packaged food, drinks, fruit and vegetables. Consider using paper drinking straws instead of plastic drinking straws. Use a drink thermos to dispense drinks into reusable glasses instead of juice boxes which are sold wrapped in plastic and have plastic drinking straws. Reducing our use of plastic waste will greatly benefit Our Planet!
- -Plan to bring your own containers for recycling glass bottles, cans and any compostable materials from your picnic outings,
