

SECOND DAY OF THE LORD IN ADVENT Prepare for God's Reign in harmony, faithfulness and steadfastness.

The Scripture readings for this second week call us to prepare for God's Reign. St. Matthew's Gospel presents St. John the Baptizer in the wilderness proclaiming because the Kingdom of heaven has come near, we must change our hearts and prepare and make straight the pathway of the Messiah. St. Paul's Letter to the Romans and us encourages us to do so in harmony with one another and steadfast faithfulness. The images in the reading from Isaiah of the animals in harmony and the child playing over the viper's nest symbolically refer to the ultimate fulfillment of God's Reign.

For many of us, these weeks can be a time of great stress and activity, as we look at our long shopping lists, decorate our homes, and plan holiday meals. As our calendar get filled with events, it can be easy to lose sight of the true reason for the season. Advent is a time of preparation. A time for creating space in our hearts and in our lives to prepare for the Christ Jesus. This is not just the Jesus who was born over 2,000 years ago in a simple manger in Bethlehem. This is also the Jesus who is waiting to be born in our world right now through hearts of peace, hands of compassion, and acts of justice.

It can be easy to crowd out the space for Jesus through busyness and buying. And yet, when we do that, as **Pope Francis** reminds us in **Laudato Si**, the impacts are dire: "The pace of consumption, waste and environmental change has so stretched the planet's capacity that our contemporary lifestyle, unsustainable as it is, can only precipitate catastrophes, such as those which even now periodically occur in different areas of the world...We need to reflect on our accountability before those who will have to endure the dire consequences." (LS, 161)
