Avoiding the commercialization of Christmas is a real challenge for everyone. The Liturgical Season of Advent helps us focus on our spiritual preparation for Christmas and on the Birth of Jesus into our hearts and homes. Advent can also be a time to "*Think Green*"! Over the Sundays of December, you and your family are encouraged to experience an Ecological Christmas Season.

On December 5th, we celebrate **World Soil Day**. We contribute to the contamination of soil in many ways, especially during the Christmas Season, through the use of plastic bags, wrapping paper, plastic disposable dishes, cups and utensils.

As you wrap gifts and celebrate with family and friends be mindful of choosing environmentally friendly alternatives to wrapping paper. Using recyclable gift bags (no tissue paper) or reusable cloth bags are good alternatives. When celebrating with family and friends use paper plates that can be recycled in the **green bin**. Remember that plastic plates and utensils go into the **blue bin**. Do your part to protect the earth from unnecessary garbage and contamination. "**Be the Solution to the Pollution!"** (FAO)
