LENT/EASTER /PENTECOST 2016

Lent begins Ash Wednesday, Feb. 10. It is a sacred time to renew our baptismal call to share more deeply in the mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. LENT is the season to deepen our own baptismal covenant while accompanying our catechumens and candidates in their preparation for the Sacraments of Initiation. During the SACRED TRIDUUM (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Paschal Vigil) we celebrate the Christian Passover, the Paschal Mystery. However, the liturgical celebration does not end with Easter. It continues on until the great FEAST OF PENTECOST, the outpouring of the Spirit.

Our celebration of this Lent/Easter/Pentecost season is a foretaste of the desire of God for all of creation to participate in the enlightenment and transformation begun in the Paschal Mystery. It prepares us to share fully in the eternal glory of God. God's Mercy endures forever.

In keeping with the traditional liturgical theme of LENT as indicated in the ASH WEDNESDAY scripture readings, we will celebrate conversion, turning (metanoia), a change of heart toward the Lord with all our hearts, as we give alms, pray and fast. Jesus in Matthew's gospel gives these as central ways of acting as His disciples.



ASH WEDNESDAY: We will have **Mass at 9** a.m., **12 Noon**, and **7:00** p.m. We will also have a prayer service at 1:15 p.m. with the staff and students of St. Raphael's School. The with ashes will occur at the three Masses and

marking with ashes will occur at the three Masses and prayer service. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat.

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK - FEBRUARY 11
The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. February 11 (Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes) highlights the healing ministry of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurses, health care institutions and pastoral caregivers to a restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease. It is an appropriate time to remember the corporal work of mercy: Visit the Sick. In addition, it is fitting to celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick in a communal celebration around this time.
