One Time Plastic Use and Plastic Gift Cards: Did you know? *Approximately 1.6 billion plastic gift cards are printed each year amounting to 9,000 tons of plastic and resulting in over 33,000 tons of CO2?* Plastic gift cards are a source of one-time use plastic that are rarely refilled and rarely recycled. They also come with a large amount of packaging that contributes to waste.

What are some alternatives to plastic gift cards?

- -Give the gift of your time in the way of offering to make a meal or to bake something, to babysit or to attend an event with the recipient of a gift!
- -Give the gift of a plant or bulbs.
- -Offer yourself to complete a service such as shoveling snow, cleaning up leaves, cutting grass.
- -Invite the recipient to your home or offer to make a meal at their home and provide the food.
- -Some stores have begun offering paper gift certificates. If you have received a plastic gift card and used it entirely, return it to the store and request that it be recycled or repurposed.
