MATTHEW'S GOSPEL THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN: THE REIGN OF GOD

The Sunday Liturgy of the Word in 2017 is **Year A, the Gospel of Matthew**. This coincides nicely with the process which the Parish Pastoral Council has been engaged in over the last few months. We have been working on a specific articulation of what **our Mission as the Parish Community of St. Raphael** can be, as well as a **Mission Statement** which will help guide us in our ministries as a **sign, instrument and foretaste of the Reign of God.**

The Infancy Account (chapters 1-2) of Matthew's Gospel proclaimed during Christmastime, brought us face-to-face with the mystery of the Incarnation, and gave us hints of the opening up of the Kingdom of Heaven in Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection. These saving events are the **Paschal Mystery** presented especially in chapters 26-28. The Paschal Mystery shows us the whole purpose of the Incarnation. Thus, in the Matthew's portrait, Jesus is, acts and speaks his message of the **Kingdom of Heaven**. The Kingdom of Heaven, various reactions to it, and the mission of the Church to continue Jesus' mission is Matthew's central theme. Note that Matthew, out of respect for the name "God", uses the expression the "Kingdom of heaven" rather than Kingdom of God. Another way of expressing this is: "The Reign of God" which implies a more dynamic sense of the metaphor Kingdom of Heaven.
