Did you know?

In North America, consumers are buying - and getting rid of - five times as much clothing as we did 25 years ago, reports Elizabeth Cline in her book *Overdressed: The Shockingly High Cost of Cheap Fashion (Portfolio, 2013).* A staggering 85 per cent of our collective apparel ends up in a landfill -that's over 10.5 million tons of clothing. In a single year, Canada produces enough textile waste - clothing and other goods like upholstery – to create a mountain three times the size of Toronto's Rogers Centre Stadium.

Reduce, reuse and recycle has become the mantra of socially conscious consumers. Now we need to extend that philosophy to our old accoutrements.

The most popular solution appears to be donating our unwanted garb. Thrift stores like those run by the YWCA across Canada not only keep old clothes out of the dump; they're also social enterprises that support community non-profits. Some charities, like the Canadian Diabetes Association, will even come to your door to collect apparel and household goods, which are resold to fund their lifechanging work. Perhaps the best way to reduce the amount of clothing in our landfills is to curb our desire to sport the latest fashion trends.
