MATTHEW'S GOSPEL

THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN: THE REIGN OF GOD The Sermon on the Mount [chapters 5-7] is the charter of God's kingdom. It is introduced this Sunday. The evangelical attitudes of the Sermon on the Mount shape our experience of the Reign of God. It is considerably longer than the Beatitudes which introduce it. Two of the Beatitudes refer directly to God's Reign: "Blessed are the **poor in spirit**, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven and "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness', for theirs is the kingdom of heaven". God's merciful compassion which is the cause of God's Reign, becomes the power and joy of human life. Human beings are called to open themselves to that love and let it be the mainspring of their lives. In the Sermon on the Mount, the "Golden Rule" stands out: "Treat others the way you would have them treat you: This sums up the law and the prophets" (7:12). We get an insight into what concrete actions that love calls for when we consider how we ourselves wish to be treated. Living the Golden Rule is living God's Reign. Fr. Frank

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD: On February 2nd the liturgy of the Church reflects on the day [40 days after the birth of Jesus] when Jesus was taken to the Temple by Joseph and Mary to fulfill the Law. Jesus was recognized by Simeon to be "the Light of the World". This Mass was formerly celebrated as the conclusion of the Christmas season. Now, the liturgy begins with a rite of blessing and procession with candles [Candlemass]. We will illuminate the wreathes and garlands in the church for this occasion recognizing Christ as the Light of the Reign of God.

Cootes Paradise is one of the largest wetland rehabilitation projects in North America. It is a habitat for hundreds of species of birds including Bald Eagles and Osprey, many varieties of fish, over 30 mammal species and more than 750 different species of native plants.
