ST. RAPHAEL GREEN CORNER
Pope Francis writes: "...yet a number
of scientific studies indicate that
most global warming in recent

decades is due to the great concentration of greenhouse gases (carbon dioxide, methane, nitrogen oxides and others) released mainly as a result of human activity. As these gases build up in the atmosphere, they hamper the escape of heat produced by sunlight at the earth's surface." Laudato Si #23

A backyard barbeque a great part of summer; but we should be concerned about the release of carbon dioxide and air pollution. Burning fossil fuels emits a number of air pollutants that are harmful to both the environment and public health.

"How can I barbecue in eco-friendly way?" Reduce your carbon imprint, use natural gas, propane, and electric grills, they burn more efficiently and cleaner than charcoal or wood grills.

Tips for Greener Barbequing: Charcoal barbecues are the least eco-friendly of all barbecues so consider upgrading to a gas or electric powered BBQ as these are considerably greener. A more natural option instead of burning standard briquettes, which give off carbon monoxide and soot is the use of lump coal. This eco-friendly, green charcoal saves our forests, while releasing less gas and soot emissions. There are green brands that are not certified, so be aware and choose certified, organic products. Eco-friendly Grilling: Purchasing quality barbequing grills will protect our environment. Be energy conscious. If the grill isn't being used for cooking turn it off.

You might want to consider a red-meat-free barbecue to truly Go Green. Beef production creates drastically higher emissions than those from chicken, fish, and vegetables. Even adjusting the ratio of burgers to chicken patties can make an eco-friendly difference!

The **Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time** begins with a reading from **Genesis**. Abraham pleads for compassion for those few innocent people of Sodom and Gomorrah. God promises him, "For the sake of those ten, I will not destroy it." Jesus teaches us to pray in the reading from **Luke's gospel**, using the familiar words, "Father, hallowed be your name." He urges us to be persistent in our prayer: "And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you."

On the **Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**, the first reading from Ecclesiastes offers a powerful caution about focusing too much on the things of this world: "Vanity of vanities! All things are vanity!" In **Luke's gospel** Jesus tells the parable of the rich man storing up treasures for the future, and he warns, "Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions."
