On this **Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (July 29/30)**, we see how God admires Solomon because he asked for wisdom rather than riches. This is very contrary to our own culture of self-glory and acquiring power and prestige. But in the long run, we know for sure, only this makes sense. So many people who go after worldly things often acknowledge how they have wasted their life only too late. Jesus is offering us the opportunity through the gospel teaching about the kingdom of heaven. He uses the metaphor of treasure, a fine pearl and the fishing net to prioritize in our life what is important for us. But the question for us is: do we know what our true treasure is? Only then we will be able to sacrifice everything for the sake of acquiring that true treasure. Let us explore what is our true treasure that can give us life to eternity.

On this **Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Aug. 5/6)**, we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord, in which we see how Jesus revealed himself in Glory. Peter in responding to this wonderful event says, 'Lord, it is good for us to be here". This can be our experience too; at times we have a meaningful conversation or a high liturgy we feel that we have had a close relationship with whom we love. But Jesus invites us, as he invited the apostles to go down into the world, rather than remain in the glory of the moment. We are called to experience God in liturgy and prayer and we are called to go out to the world.
