

Laudato Si #92 **Did you know** that there is a movement to organic farms here in Canada? What is Organic farming? Organic farming is a method of farming whereby farmers seek to use alternative methods of farming such as planting winter cover crops, field rotation, and the natural fertilizers such as compost and manure to grow crops instead of chemical fertilizers and pesticides. For the most part Organic farming is done on a smaller scale locally and allows us access to locally grown vegetables and fruits. Because synthetic fertilizers are not employed it reduces the use of chemicals that end up in our lakes, rivers, and water systems due to runoff from rain. Organic farming techniques are used by small scale farmers that we often meet at the local Farmers Markets. Supporting organic farmers not only contributes to their lively hood and welfare but also helps to ensure that organic farming practices continue to protect our environment! PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO THE QUEBEC SHRINES AND **OTTAWA:** Join your fellow parishioners on a Pilgrimage to the Quebec Shrines on Saturday, Sep 1- Monday, Sep **03**, **2018**. The parish has organized a 3-day pilgrimage to many of the most beautiful and historic places of worship and spirituality in Quebec including St. Joseph's Oratory, Our Lady of the Cape Shrine, Notre Dame Cathedral Basilica and St. Anne de Beaupre Basilica. We will be staying at Hotel Maison de la Madone in Trois Rivières both nights and traveling by coach to the sites. The cost is \$400 per pilgrim based on single, \$ 350 pp based on double and \$300 pp based on a triple, and \$280 pp based on quad occupancy and includes a 2-night stay, 2 breakfasts, 2 dinners, transportation, tips, and gratuities.
