

Today, June 17th is World Desertification Day! Desertification is a phenomenon that ranks among the greatest environmental challenges of our time. Yet most people haven't heard of it or don't understand it. Desertification is the process by which land becomes so dry that it cannot be used for farming. It is caused by clear cutting trees and plant removal, the over use of soil for farming and grazing of animals on the land. It is global issue with serious implications worldwide for biodiversity, eco safety, poverty eradication, socio-economic stability, and sustainable development. Some people 50 million people may be displaced within the next ten years as a result of desertification.

What can we do? To prevent soil erosion, support the planting of native trees and plants in your garden and in your neighbourhood, in order to prevent soil erosion. Manage water use by using a rain barrel to collect rainwater and water gardens and plants. Use natural means to fertilize gardens and lawns. Compost and mulch garden waste and add it to gardens to enrich soil and prevent soil loss during heavy down pours of rain. When cutting your lawn use a mulching blade and leave the clippings on the lawn. Lawn clippings are high in nitrogen and provide a natural way to fertilize your lawn and retain moisture in the soil during hot dry summers, therefore less need to water your lawn.

PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO THE QUEBEC SHRINES AND OTTAWA: Join your fellow parishioners on a Pilgrimage to the Quebec Shrines on Saturday, Sep 1- Monday, Sep 03, 2018. The parish has organized a 3-day pilgrimage to many of the most beautiful and historic places of worship and spirituality in Quebec including St. Joseph's Oratory, Our Lady of the Cape Shrine, Notre Dame Cathedral Basilica and St. Anne de Beaupre Basilica. We will be staying at Hotel Maison de la Madone in Trois Rivières both nights and traveling by coach to the sites.
