TWELFTH DAY OF THE LORD IN ORDINARY TIME

A favorite musical of mine is *Les Miserables*. I love listening to the story of Jean Valjean, the man who struggles to carve out a life despite many hardships. In the musical he sings at one point, "**Who am I?**" – reflecting on his need to be honest about his past and his commitment to God.

Today, in our Gospel, Jesus asks the same question of his disciples: first, who do people say that he is, then—more personally—"**Who do you say that I am?**" Jesus answers his questions by acknowledging that he is indeed the **Messiah, the Christ sent by God**, and by defining that role in his suffering, death and resurrection.

In the second reading, Saint Paul gives us a glimpse of our Christian identity. We belong to Christ. Our nationality or race, our social status, even our gender are distinctions that do not apply to the Christian. Our identity in and with Jesus comes through Baptism, and "clothes" us throughout our lives.

Who am I? Today as you attend Mass, look around you. If you're prone to making distinctions among people (and we all do), let those differences give way for a while to the common identity we all share with Christ.

THE JOY OF LOVE: THE FAMILY [Pope Francis]

175: A **father**, for his part, helps the child to perceive the limits of life, to be open to the challenges of the wider world, and to see the need for hard work and strenuous effort. A **father** possessed of a clear and serene masculine identity who demonstrates affection and concern for his wife is just as necessary as a caring mother. There can be a certain flexibility of roles and responsibilities, depending on the concrete circumstances of each particular family. But the clear and well-defined presence of both figures, female and male, creates the environment best suited to the growth of the child.

#177: God sets the **father** in the family so that by the gifts of his masculinity he can be "close to his wife and share everything, joy and sorrow, hope and hardship. And to be close to his children as they grow – when they play and when they work, when they are carefree and when they are distressed, when they are talkative and when they are silent, when they are daring and when they are afraid, when they stray and when they get back on the right path.

FR. FRANK'S WORK IN ROME: Every 6 years the worldwide Congregation of Holy Cross Priests and Brothers meets in Rome for their General Council. I will be representing the **Region of Holy Cross in English Canada**. The Chapter reflects on the ministry and mission of the Congregation during the last six years and plans for the next six years. The General Chapter begins July 2nd and ends July 25th. After that, I will spend a few days in Belgium and Netherlands before doing the ministry of priest/chaplain on the cruise ship *Konigsdam* (Holland America Lines) cruising the fiords of Norway.
