Canada must ban neonics. What is a neonicotinoid? Neonicotinoids are a new class of insecticides chemically related to nicotine. A report from the European Union's scientific risk assessment authority concludes neonicotinoid pesticides pose a serious danger to honeybees and wild bees. Recently, the European Commission voted to ban all outdoor agricultural uses of neonics by the end of 2018. This decision is a victory for the bees and the environment. We need parallel action to protect bees in Canada! It is important to make sure your outdoor fun or activity is toxin free.

Make Your Own Bug Repellent! Before you go out and buy expensive chemical bug repellent, try making your own first.
