A little bit about our Pastor, Fr. Frank...

Fr. Frank's hometown is Port Colborne ON. Almost all of his educational history has been in Catholic institutions, starting at St. John Bosco School in Pt. Colborne, and then at Notre Dame College School Welland, ON, where he joined the Holy Cross Fathers' pre-novitiate program in 1957, Holy Cross Novitiate in Vermont 1958, University of Notre Dame, Indiana at Moreau Seminary for his BA degree 1959-1963 and Scholasticat Notre Dame de Sainte Croix, Montreal 1963-1967 for the B.Th. degree. He was ordained in his home town parish St. John Bosco on December 17, 1966. He taught at Dennis Morris High School in St. Catharines, ON from 1967-1969 and then from 1969 to 1984 he guided the Formation program and vocation promotion at Holy Cross House, Fredericton, NB on the campus of St. Thomas University/ University of New Brunswick. In addition, he served there in local parishes and was chaplain and lecturer in Sacred Scripture at STU. During those years he was involved in many civic activities, helping to found the Fredericton Group Home, the Chimo Crisis Centre, the Fredericton Emergency Shelter and Food Kitchen, as well as doing summer stints as padre for Air Cadet Camps in Nova Scotia and Alberta.

Through part-time studies, he obtained a MEd from the University of New Brunswick in 1975. In 1984 he became chaplain at Brock University in St. Catharines, ON and taught there in the Faculty of Education for five years preparing future teachers for the Roman Catholic School System. While chaplain and doing doctoral studies, he did weekend ministry for ten years at St. Julia parish in St. Catharines. He obtained through part-time studies an MTh degree from St. Michael's University College, Toronto in 1985. He did doctoral studies at OISE/University of Toronto 1990-1992 and obtained the doctorate in Education in 1994.

He was director of the Basilian Pastoral Centre from 1992-1995, after which he became pastor of St. Kevin Parish, Welland, for nine years. He became pastor of St. Ann Parish, Toronto and Director and team member of the Holy Cross Fathers' formation program for theology students located in the parish rectory from 2005-2012. He accepted from the Archdiocese of Toronto the administration of St. Joseph Parish in 2011 and the Native Peoples' Mission in 2008.

Fr. Frank also has enjoyed leading nine pilgrimages in many countries since 2000 and about 21 sailings as the priest chaplain on Holland America cruise ships since 1996. He is an "at-large" member of the Ontario Liturgical Commission, a past member of the Archdiocese of Toronto priests' council, was Zone One chair for five years and chair of the committee which articulated the objectives of the 2014 Archdiocese of Toronto pastoral plan for parishes. He is presently assistant superior of the Region of English Canada Holy Cross Fathers. He began a "fun time" sabbatical in November 2013, which included several cruises as chaplain and a month in a Benedictine Monastery (Arizona in February/March!!). He was appointed to the ministry for one year as full-time Director of St. Joseph Chapel at the Archdiocese of Toronto Holy Cross Cemetery, Thornhill in August 2014.

A little bit about our Associate Pastor, Fr. Francis...

Father Francis was born on 14-7-1981 in a village called N. Poolampatty, in the state of Tamil Nadu, India. He has two brothers and was born as a second child. He hails from a middle class, traditional Roman Catholic family. His family's main occupation is farming. Fr. Francis did his primary education in a Catholic Parish School and for High School moved on to the Government School, after which he decided to join the seminary to become a priest. Fr. Francis joined the congregation of Holy Cross in the year 1999. He had his formation in different parts of India, during which he also completed his Bachelor of Arts in Bangalore and Bachelor of Philosophy in Pune, India. He then moved to Toronto, Canada, to do his Master of Divinity and Masters in Sacred Theology at the University of Toronto. He was ordained as a Deacon in Toronto in May 2011, and ordained as a priest on December 3, 2011 in India. After his Ordination he returned to Canada to complete his STM and began to work at St. Ignatius Loyola parish in Mississauga where he has completed three years. He is excited to begin his new journey at St. Raphael's Parish.
