FROM THE YOUTH MINISTER: Question of the Week: A weekly reflection to help us grow in our faith and relation with God. Continued from last week: What does it mean that a Christian is a new creation? 2 Corinthians 5:17. To understand the new creation, first we must grasp that it is in fact a creation, something created by God. John 1:13 "who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God..." tell us that this new birth was brought about by the will, love and mercy of God. We did not inherit the new nature, nor did we decide to re-create ourselves anew, nor did God simply clean up our old nature: He created something entirely fresh and unique. The new creation is completely new, brought about from nothing, just as the whole universe was created by God 'ex nihilo': from nothing. Only the Creator could accomplish such a feat.

Old things have passed away, the old refers to everything that is part of our old nature – natural pride, sin, reliance on works and our former opinions, habits and passions. The "new creation" looks outwardly toward Christ instead of inwardly toward self. The old things died along with the old passing away: the new creation has come.
