There will be a communal preparation with several priests to hear confessions and give absolution. **Tuesday**, **March 22**, **from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m**.



HOLY THURSDAY LITURGY
We turn our hearts to Jesus who
is the Servant of God for others.
During the Liturgy of Thursday of
the Lord's Supper (March 24,
8:00 p.m.), the Church invites us to
the Rite of Foot Washing. This
symbolic gesture calls to mind the
action of Jesus the Servant, Who

washed the feet of His disciples at the **Last Supper**. It is the first day of the **Sacred Paschal Triduum**, the three days of our highest holydays which celebrate the Paschal Mystery of Jesus Christ. If you would like to have your feet washed, just bring a towel and sit near the end of a pew.

GOOD FRIDAY We turn our hearts to Jesus who is the Suffering servant of mercy. The Divine Liturgy of the Passion begins at three o'clock in the afternoon and a Dramatization of the Way of the Cross at eight p.m. Participate in both to deepen your love of Jesus whose death showed His profound merciful love for humanity.

HOLY SATURDAY We turn our hearts to Jesus whose mercy bring us the glory of the Resurrection

EASTER PASCHAL VIGIL: The most solemn liturgy of our Roman Catholic year of worship begins at sundown about 8:00 p.m. The whole celebration is filled with most wondrous symbols, music, Scripture readings and sharing in the mystery of the Resurrection of the Lord. Four persons will be baptized in our new baptismal pool and then with four others they will receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist. Christ is Risen! He is risen indeed!

REQUEST FROM BISHOP CROSBY ON PATIENT ASSISTED DYING (EUTHANASIA)

Assisted suicide will soon be legal in Canada. The twentyone recommendations that the parliamentary committee has proposed to the Federal Government go far beyond what the Supreme Court mandated. They include a requirement that doctors who have a moral objection to assisted suicide must, against their wishes, refer their patients to a doctor who will engage in this process. No other country in the world requires this kind of violation of conscience!

As Bishop of the Hamilton Diocese, I encourage you to visit our website www.hamiltondiocese.com to get a fuller understanding of this issue. I also ask you to write directly to your Member of Parliament. Voice your concerns that the law be written in such a way that it protects those who are vulnerable, as well as the conscience rights of individuals and Catholic institutions involved in health care. The Coalition for HealthCARE and Conscience, made up of numerous partners (including more than 5,000 Canadian doctors) has all the information you will need to write such a letter on their website at www.CanadiansforConscience.ca. History is being made at this moment – as Catholics we have both the right and obligation to participate in this important process.
