Air Travel and Carbon Emissions: Many of us have planned future trips across our country and abroad that have a substantial carbon footprint! Scientists calculate a person taking one return flight from eastern North America to central Europe generates about the same amount of carbon emissions as they would use commuting 25 kilometer a day for an entire year in a fuelefficient car. There are numerous ways that we can reduce our carbon footprint when travelling by air, such as reducing the amount that we pack to take on a flight (lessen over all weight on the aircraft), booking an economy seat which allows more people to travel on a flight, and flying during the day rather than evening. 
