

PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO THE QUEBEC SHRINES AND **OTTAWA:** Join your fellow parishioners on a Pilgrimage to the Quebec Shrines on Saturday, Sep 1- Monday, Sep 3, 2018. The parish has organized a 3-day pilgrimage to many of the most beautiful and historic places of worship and spirituality in Quebec including St. Joseph's Oratory, Our Lady of the Cape Shrine, Notre Dame Cathedral Basilica and St. Anne de Beaupre Basilica.
