#### HEROES OF HOLY CROSS: Fr. Patrick Peyton, CSC

(Part 4 of 4): By the time of his death, he had helped produce over 600 television and radio shows. He

had also overseen the production of three feature-length epics on the life of Christ, divided into the Joyful, Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary. Peyton was a man with hope to bring. He labored with the rich and the poor, the famous and the ignored, to promote prayer in our world. This continues today through Holy Cross Family Ministries, which includes Family Rosary, and Family Theater Productions. In June of 2001 the formal Cause of Canonization was introduced at the Holy See. As a Servant of God, Peyton's virtues are recognized for imitation. His saintly example engenders in the Congregation the desire to be loyal sons of Our Lady, seeking her motherly intercession as we are prayerfully attentive to the needs of the Church and the world.
