November 25th is **Black Friday** in North America, the day that many people engage in a Christmas Shopping Frenzie. Why not consider attending the screening of the documentary film "The True Cost; Who Pays the Price for our Clothing?", to be screened at Burlington Central Library, on Thursday November 24th from 7-9pm, doors open at 6:30pm, cost \$5 per person. "This is a story about clothing. It's about the clothes we wear, the people who make them, and the impact the industry is having on our world. The price of clothing has been decreasing for decades, while the human and environmental costs have grown dramatically."
