R.C.I.A.: This Sunday, during the 9:00 a.m. Mass, two adults and one young person formally begin, through the Rite of Acceptance, their journey in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). This process of faith development will be completed with the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) during the Easter Vigil on March 26<sup>th</sup>. During the 11:00 a.m. Mass, we formally celebrate the Rite of Welcoming for those who have been baptized in other Christian ecclesial traditions, but now are in the process of preparing for sacrament of Confirmation and full Communion in the Eucharist.

#### **ADVENT • CHRISTMAS • EPIPHANY**

This liturgical season celebrates the coming of Christ which fulfils our hope-filled longings. It focuses on three aspects of the coming of Jesus Christ.

- 1. His final coming as the Son of Man in glory;
- 2. His first coming at his birth in Bethlehem;
- 3. His continuing coming to us in the sacraments and in his presence in us by grace.

Pope Francis, in calling the liturgical year 2015-16 a Jubilee Year of Mercy, says: "We want to live this Jubilee Year in light of the Lord's words: Merciful like the Father. The Evangelist reminds us of the teaching of Jesus who says, "Be merciful just as your Father is merciful" (Lk 6:36). The guiding theme for our liturgies during the Advent/Christmas season will be:

Hope in the Coming of the Mercy of God.

The mercy of God, incarnate in the birth in Jesus Christ who is the merciful Face of God, touches our lives now, and will be fulfilled in the final coming of the Christ in glory. Each weekend our liturgies will reflect on the merciful action of God for us.

## The First Day of the Lord of Advent theme is: Be Alert! The Merciful Lord will come in glory.

Especially the Gospel of Luke and the Responsorial Psalm encourage us to watch with alertness for the final glorious coming of Christ when God's steadfast love and plan of harmony for the universe is complete. Being alert at all times will motivate us to abound in love for one another and for all, as St. Paul's letter reminds us.

MESSAGE FROM POPE FRANCIS: "Faced with the tragic events of human history, we can feel crushed at times, asking ourselves, 'Why?' Humanity's evil can appear in the world like an abyss, a great void: empty of love, empty of goodness, empty of life. And so we ask: how can we fill the abyss? For us it is impossible; only God can fill this emptiness that evil brings to our hearts and to human history. It is Jesus, God made man, Who died on the Cross and Who fills the abyss of sin with the depth of His mercy."

JESSE TREE During the Advent season our children in the Children's Liturgy of the Word will help decorate our Jesse Tree. The Jesse Tree represents the family tree of Jesus Christ. It tells the story of God's salvation plan, beginning with creation and continuing through the Old Testament, to the coming of the Messiah. The symbolic ornaments can each represent a prophecy foretelling of Christ. Other variations include ornaments that represent the ancestors in the lineage of Christ, or the various symbols of Christianity.
